Mental Health Crisis Support Home

The Mental Health Crisis Support Home Program is designed to provide a home environment in which adolescents (age 12-17) can achieve stability while away from their own home receiving mental health services within the community.

Here's what your contribution will be as a **Mental Health Crisis Support Home**

- * Provide a safe home environment on an on call basis where an adolescent will stay with you for 21- 30 days at a time
- * Model a safe and healthy lifestyle
- * Liaise with family members and mental health workers to best support adolescents
- * Support adolescents to be safe, attend daily activities, access community resources and attend mental health appointments

Here's what you will need to get an interview:

- * High School Diploma and/or Post Secondary Education in the Human Services field
- * Genuine interest in working with youth
- * Knowledge of existing community resources and understanding of issues related to mental health and addictions
- * Must have own place of residence, with an available bedroom for an adolescent
- * Current Standard First Aid/CPR, Suicide Intervention (Training may be provided if necessary)
- * Valid Alberta Driver's License, and daily use of a reliable vehicle
- * Child Welfare Intervention Check and Criminal Record Check (within 6 months)
