The Youth Transition to Adulthood program is designed to provide a setting in which adolescents can achieve normalized, successful independence. Here's what your contribution will be as a **Home Based Resident Worker** within YTA

- \* The Resident Worker is a home based position where a youth (aged 15-24) will live in your home with you.
- \* The Resident Worker will model a healthy lifestyle, and support youth with life skills such as meals, cleaning, etc.
- \* Help clients, using a strength-based, client-centered approach.

### **Here's what you will need to get an interview:**

- \* High School Diploma and/or Post Secondary Education, Degree/Diploma in Human Services preferred
- \* Genuine interest in working with youth
- \* Knowledge of existing community resources and understanding of issues related to mental health and addictions
- \* Must have own place of residence, with an available bedroom for a teen
- \* Current Standard First Aid/CPR; ASIST/Suicide Intervention
- \* Valid Alberta Driver's License, and daily use of a reliable vehicle
- \* Child Welfare Intervention Check and Criminal Records Check (within 6 months)
