We are looking for an exceptional **person** to join the **PCAP** program with McMan South based in Pincher Creek and provides services throughout the Crowsnest Pass and Piikani Nation areas.

This position is 35 hours a week, will run from May 31 - July 30, 2021

Here is how you will contribute as a **Mentor** with the PCAP Program:

- Work with the team to provide a variety of services designed to support Indigenous woman with community connections; rurally, on reserve and in Lethbridge.
- Day to day Intensive Case Management and service delivery using a participant-centered, harm reduction and strength-based approach.
- Supporting women with planned parenthood or gaining access to birth control and other health needs.
- Maintain all file documentation, accurate data collection and case notes.
- Complete participant customized case plans based upon available community resources.
- Provide crisis support and referrals for participants as required.
- Work with multidisciplinary team partners including community and cultural resources, among others.
- Be flexible and able to travel to respond to program needs.

- Hands on experience with Intensive Case Management.
- Ongoing paid training.
- Flexible work schedule – *Note that the start/end date is not flexible and the individual must commit to the full 8-week period at 35 hours/week.*

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in a Degree/Diploma in addiction counselling, social work, child and youth care or related field.
- Education and/or experience working with Indigenous women, individuals with addictions and/or family systems. A combination of experience and education may be considered.
- Knowledge of community resources on the Piikani Nation, in Pincher Creek and in Lethbridge.
- Due to Canada Summer Jobs funder restrictions eligible individuals for this position must be between the age of 18 and 30
- Knowledge of skills and techniques known to help with behaviour change including cognitive behaviour therapy, motivational interviewing, leadership, and mentorship.
- Demonstrated strong communication and administrative skills with acute attention to accuracy and detail.
- Clear Criminal Record Check including vulnerable sector and Child Intervention Checks dated within the past 90 days, Driver's Abstract within the past 6 months, valid Driver's License, use of reliable vehicle and minimum \$2M vehicle insurance.
- Standard First Aid CPR Level C Certificate
